Compensation, Hours and Benefits: Compensation for this position starts at Coordinator level 1 at 33.17/hr up to Coordinator level 4 at 39.79/hr and is commensurate with experience. We value the time of our employees. This position is for a 32 hour work week. Monday through Thursday 10-6, lunch hour and afternoon break are paid. There are 4 weeks of paid vacation per year, 8 paid holidays, 48 hours of paid sick leave, healthcare with a \$200 month company contribution as well as optional vision and dental. Position Summary: The occupant of this position will finish closed-corner frames for fine art clients with solid lacquers, stains, and decorative finishes, using HVLP, hand and brush applied techniques, Faux finishes, and water gilding. They will meet project deadlines and identify and implement improvements in painting/finishing facilities and procedures. They will participate in research and development of new finishing techniques and technologies. The occupant of this position will train and mentor any junior staff assigned to them, setting the pace for work and ensuring quality control. The ideal candidate for this position will have several years of fine wood finishing experience in a leadership position in precision production environments such as fine art framing & furniture making.
